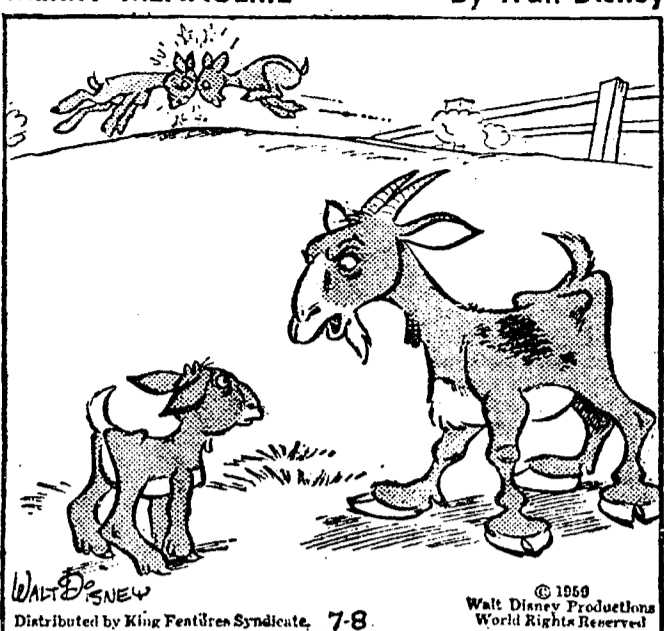

Philip Makes Big Hit With Girls

Prince Philip made a hit with girls of all ages Monday, and thoroughly enjoyed himself.

The handsome, tall, 38-year-old Prince was jaunty from the time he stopped ashore from the royal barge Monday morning.

As the royal caravan inched its way through Chicago streets during the day, girls—young and old—asked "Where is Philip?"

Many said he was handsome. One got carried away. "Isn't he pretty," she said, pushing a reporter off a chair so she could get a better look.

Only once did he show some of the strain of the crowds, reporters and photographers. Surrounded by popping flashbulbs at the Trade Fair, the Prince said with slight irritation, "Much more of this and I'm going to get flashbulb popitis."

He ate well. At the fancy luncheon at the Ambassador West hotel, vice president Max Blouet said "Prince Philip cleaned every plate in front of him and never stopped

talking to Mrs. Daley. At the reception the Prince was unusually cordial, laughed and seemed well informed about most of the people he met.

"You aren't wearing your green bow tie," he said to Michigan Gov. G. Mennen Williams, who was wearing a black bow tie with polka dots.

"That's because I'm not running for election this year," William replied.

Philip spent two or three minutes talking with Gov. George Docking of Kansas, and "chit-chatted" with Illinois Gov. William Stratton.

Egan Names Another Police Chief

AURORA, Ill.—(UPI) — Mayor Egan named another police chief Monday during a city council meeting, but the council, as it has in the past, took coldly to the suggestion.

It refused to confirm Egan's appointment of John Kramoski as chief. Kramoski operates a small tool and die shop here, and was in Michigan when the appointment was announced. Egan said he had written a letter to Kramoski.

Egan has tried to remove Donald F. Carran as chief of Aurora police for about a year and a half, but the council will have none of it.

Slice Up Red Carpet Made For Elizabeth

The 2,300 feet of red carpet over which Queen Elizabeth and Prince Philip walked at the International Trade Fair Monday was sliced up and offered for sale for hospital aid and medical research at \$10,000 per 100 feet.

Sol Polk, president of Polk Brother, Chicago, who had the carpet manufactured for the Queen's visit, said "each person or organization donating \$10,000 to a Chicago nonprofit organization, will be given 100 feet of red carpet."

"In this way we hope to help advanced medical science in Chicago. Almost a quarter of a million dollars for hospitals and medical research can be raised in this way," Polk said.

Chicagoans mumbled, too, that the mayor spent too much money preparing for the queen's visit, but the mayor's office retaliated by saying that the money spent in the city by visiting delegations more than paid for the queen's visit.

It was obvious that Chicagoans didn't quite know how to receive the visiting guests. Should they throw confetti, clap loudly and uproarously, and duplicate a scene reminiscent of a presidential convention?

But the crowds were subdued, almost silent at times and it was not until the evening parade from the Drake hotel to the Conrad Hilton hotel that people decided noise was really appropriate even for a queenly visit.

It was a great day, perhaps the greatest in the annals of Chicago history. If this day, July 6, could assure the success of the St. Lawrence Seaway, and make Chicago the greatest seaport in the world, surely the city's success is an unchallenged conclusion.
