

Burglars Get Sugar Without Ration Cards

Nowadays burglars steal nothing out sugar and spice and everything . . . rationed.

At least that's what Capt. Edward Kelly of the Pekin police station at 27th and State streets believes.

Take two of the typical robberies over last weekend.

When thieves broke into the Puritan Food Products company at 2536 S. Indiana avenue, they took four tons of sugar, 50 cases of pineapple juice (which will be on the ration list next month) and two trucks to transport their load.

At the Triple-S Machine company, 2954 Sheffield avenue, the haul was \$600 worth of precision instruments.

Not a cent in cash was taken in either instance. Cash is not rationed yet.
