

A hard day's night for 85 girls

Eighty-five casualties was the toll up to 10 o'clock last night, when the Beatles' first film, "A Hard Day's Night" had its premiere at the London Pavilion. The casualties were mostly girls who fainted or suffered from hysteria. None was taken to hospital. A crowd of 12,000 greeted the Beatles when they arrived at the cinema. The Beatles were presented to Princess Margaret and Lord Snowden before the premiere.
