Results will include a range of editorials that show robust debate on the merits and flaws in affirmative action as viewed by the Asian American community. These editorials provide interesting reading in light of the statistically high performance of Asian American students.

Search for: Articles that refer to Asian cuisine

WORDS IN ARTICLE: **Asian cuisine**

Results include articles about Chinese hamburgers, Chinese fast food á la McDonald's, health issues regarding soy sauce and learning to grow mushrooms. Later articles trace the development of Pan-Asian cuisine.

Search for: Articles that include websites for education or legislative issues

WORDS IN ARTICLE: **website* AND (legislat* OR educat*)**
ETHNIC GROUP: **Asian/Pacific Islander**
